Read through one chapter of Daniel six days each week. Answer one question about the chapter.

By the end of eleven weeks, you will have read all of Daniel about five and a half times and answered eleven key questions about this amazing book on courage and visions.

Start on the week or date listed below, using that Sunday as the start of the week.

WEEK 1: AUGUST 18

READ CHAPTERS 1–6

What does this chapter teach about courage?

WEEK 2: AUGUST 21

READ CHAPTERS 7–12

List the symbols found in this chapter's vision. What does each symbol represent?

WEEK 3: AUGUST 28

READ CHAPTERS 1–6

How did God reach the king in this chapter?

WEEK 4: SEPTEMBER 4

READ CHAPTERS 7–12

Does this vision refer to a past event, a future event, or both?

WEEK 5: SEPTEMBER 11

READ CHAPTERS 1–6

How does God view each character in this chapter?

WEEK 6: SEPTEMBER 18

READ CHAPTERS 7–12

Why do you think God put this text in the Bible?

WEEK 7: SEPTEMBER 25

READ CHAPTERS 1–6

How might our culture be similar to the ancient cultures in applying pressure to reject God?

WEEK 8: OCTOBER 2

READ CHAPTERS 7–12

What does this chapter reveal about God’s character or his plans for us?

WEEK 9: OCTOBER 9

READ CHAPTERS 1–6

How were Daniel and his friends God’s agents in this passage?

WEEK 10: OCTOBER 16

READ CHAPTERS 7–12

What does this vision reveal about empires, God’s sovereignty, or the spiritual realm?

WEEK 11: OCTOBER 23

READ CHAPTERS 1–6

What qualities of God’s character are displayed in this chapter?
